ERASMUS project	Jo Ward attended the meeting to provide an overview of a green space volunteer-led conservation group in Stockport, a project funded through ERASMUS. The project has partners in Belgium, Spain, Malta, Greece, Ireland, Portugal and the UK (with HMVCG being the UK partner). Key elements of the programme in the UK is a focus on influencing treatment and support for cancer patients, and workforce education. The key outputs of the programme are to: • Develop a training programme and resources to enable scale and spread of green social prescribing.	MI /MI	30 mins

	The outcomes of the project are to improve social inclusion and diversity in civic engagement whilst at the same time reducing health disparities and inequalities. In addition, the SPACE Community of Practice will promote a methodology leading to increased quality of activities and practices.		
	The project will kick off end November/beginning December with a formal start in January. The duration is three years.
